information presented on the first acrylics workshop ("Reliable Results in Acrylics: A Medium Demystified"), in "Painting Nature's Textures in Acrylics" David teaches intuitive **Painting Nature's Textures** methods for imitating natural textures like grass, bark, feathers, and eyes. David further demonstrates how you can create optical texture by using his signature method of applying transparent washes over opaque layers.
